Quiet Girl - A Powerful All-Girl Band from Lübeck

Quiet Girl is a young rock band from Lübeck, founded in **early 2024**. The three musicians — **Nele (guitar & vocals)**, **Merle (bass & vocals)**, and **Ina (drums)** — were between **14 and 17 years old** at the time of the band's formation. The deliberately provocative band name plays with the stereotype of the "quiet girl" and turns it on its head with loud, uncompromising music.

Musically, Quiet Girl move between **alternative metal, punk, and post-grunge** — raw, emotional, and high-energy, with an **intense live presence**. The band stand not only for music, but for a clear attitude: **gender equality, visibility, and self-assertion** in a music scene that is still strongly male-dominated. Their own experiences with sexism and discrimination were a central motivation behind the band's formation.

Quiet Girl aim to create visibility, challenge stereotypes, and encourage young women to confidently follow their own path.

In **2025**, the band recorded their first songs with producer **Lasse Lammert**. These recordings are currently being developed into five short films that address socially relevant topics such as sexism, bullying, and self-doubt — partly animated, partly live-action. The releases will begin in 2026.

In **September 2025**, an additional song was recorded at **Jak's Hell Studio** under the direction of **Jens Krabbenhöft**.

The **debut EP "Don't Be Quiet"**, featuring a total of six songs, will be released on **February 6, 2026** via **Bandcamp** as well as on all major streaming platforms — deliberately **excluding Spotify**. Earlier, on **December 12, 2025**, the band released **"Schaukelsong"**, a standalone music video from the EP.

Since 2024, Quiet Girl have celebrated numerous successes:

- **CLASSICAL BEAT Young Talents Award** (July 2024, 1st place)
- **Finalists at the Local Heroes contest** during Kiel Week (June 2024)
- **Emergenza Contest**: 1st place in the preliminary round (May 2025), 2nd place in the Northern final (June 2025)
- Performances at **RockTreff Berlin**, **Radio BOB! Rockcamp**, and a TV feature on **NDR Schleswig-Holstein Magazin** (June 2025)
- Quiet Girl are among the selected artists of the 42nd edition of **Treffen junge Musikszene at the Berliner Festspiele** and thus one of the 14 **award winners** of this year's competition.

Outlook: Quiet Girl combine artistic energy with social commitment. Loud, direct, and unapologetic, they are well on their way to becoming one of the most exciting young rock bands in Germany.
